

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Policies, Terms & Conditions

The terms and conditions herein are deemed to have been read, understood and agreed once the course booking has been processed. These terms and conditions are binding once the application form has been signed and submitted.

In the event that the terms and conditions herein are inconsistent with the Application Form, these shall prevail.

Fees

Full payment of the course fees must be received by the date of the course/class commencement. 50% required in advance to secure placement in S.E.M.P program. It is at the discretion of the School to accept payment agreement terms. A receipt will be given for the fees paid and any balances outstanding.

Methods of payment

Fees and deposits can be paid Cash, Check, DD and wire transfers. All checks must be made in favor of Tribhovandas Bhimji Zaveri Entertainment (P) Ltd. ENZY School of Music & Technology will require a Pan card of individual or company if the billing amount is over inr 20,000. Payments for individual lessons must be paid in full prior to the scheduled course.

Late Applications

Provided that a course has not been closed for bookings, the School may accept further bookings till the day of commencement of the course. Confirmation of course booking for late applicants would be done by the School by telephone or via email. If no formal confirmation from the School has been received within 24 hours of the submission of application, it shall be the duty of the applicant to contact the School to confirm the status of the booking.

Class timings and Hours

ENZY School of Music & technology will provide a time table and schedule to the Students prior to start of the course/class. These hours will be strictly followed by teachers and the school. The class duration and timings will be adhered by the teachers strictly and attendance deduction marks will be given to the students who fail to reach on time.

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Non-resident overseas applications

Contact details of the applicant must be provided when booking. The applicant must ensure that the details provided are in full and correct. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the course is still available and that the booking has been confirmed prior to making any travel arrangements. The Institute will in no way be liable for any travel or accommodation expenses and/ or any losses howsoever incurred if in any event the applicant cancels the booking. No refunds of fees and/or deposits will be provided should there be a cancellation once payment has been affected. The School has the sole discretion to provide a refund if there is a good and sufficient reason to.

Students under the age of 12

Parents or guardians of students under the age of 12 must inform the School if the student is allowed to travel by public transport or not. It shall be the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian to ensure the student has arrived safely. At no time will the School be responsible for the student before arriving, while on the premises or after leaving the School. All applications must be co-signed by the parent or guardian in order for them to be processed.

Cancellation and Non Attendance by the Applicant

Cancellation or non-attendance due to illness or for personal or professional reasons does not entitle the applicant to a refund, extra tuition or a transfer. However, in such an event the School will consider all the relevant circumstances and take proceed in a fair and reasonable manner. Kindly note that if any alternatives are offered additional charges may apply.

Cancellation by the School

The School reserves the right to amend or cancel courses, change course dates, substitute educators/teachers at any time. The School guarantees a three (3) working day notice where a course is cancelled or rescheduled unless cancellation is due to unexpected emergency or weather related. Student will be contacted via email in such a case. The applicant will be given an option to choose another related course or to be given a full refund of the course fees or of the classes cancelled. The School will provide refunds within one month from notification. The School will not, in any manner whatsoever, be liable for any losses including, but not limited to, travel and accommodation expenses arising as a consequence of any modification or cancellation of courses.

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Rescheduling of Classes by the School

If a particular class is postponed for reasons for which the School is responsible, such as staff illness, the School will ensure that the class is rescheduled or where this is not possible, to add the missed hours on to the remaining course classes.

Use of the Studio

ENZY School faculty authorization is required each and every time before using any piece of ENZY equipment (including computers) and instruments. While at the School, students are not allowed to install any software without the consent of School staff, or change any computer set-ups or passwords. Authorization must be sought before students can use any external storage devices (such as USBs or pen drives). No mobile phone, games or any other similar electronic equipment, unless with the consent of the School's staff, is allowed to be used during class. Smoking in the Institute premises is strictly prohibited. Eating/drinking in class is not allowed. Students are to handle all computer equipment and all instruments provided for their learning with utmost care.

Course Language

All classes are taught in English. Applicants whose first language is not English should note that they are required to be proficient in written and spoken English and be able to participate in group discussions and presentations in English. If all students and educator are in agreement, lessons may be conducted in Hindi.

Student Conduct

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner and to recognize that other students may require support and assistance. If a student becomes persistently disruptive, the School reserves the right to give a verbal and/or written warning. If a student is dismissed for misconduct, no refund will be given. Students are encouraged to arrive for classes on time. Late entry to the class is at the discretion of the educator/teacher.

No drugs, alcohol or non-vegetarian foods will be allowed to be used or consumed on the premises.

Data Protection

The School endeavors to keep any personal information, divulged by the applicant, confidential. Such personal data will not be given to third parties. Personal information will only be used for educational, promotional or marketing purposes unless the applicant does not wish to receive such information.

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Liability

The School, its employees and representatives accept no responsibility for any loss of or damage to personal belongings or property of the student, or for any personal injury to or death of a student occurring on the School premises and/or while using transport services if any, provided by the School, whether by fire, theft, evacuation or by any force majeure event. Nor is the School, its employees or representatives liable for damages for cessation of operation and resulting cancellation of courses due to an event outside the School's control. The School shall have no obligations, duties or liabilities whatsoever in contract, tort or otherwise arising out of the use of the services provided by the School. To the maximum extent permitted by law, the School and its respective educators/teachers hereby disclaims all warranties, terms and conditions by statute, or otherwise of satisfactory quality, fitness for a particular purpose, title and non infringement of the courses provided and the services provided to teach the courses and in no event shall the School or its educators/ teachers be liable for any loss of opportunity, profits, loss of revenues, wasted time, wasted costs, indirect, incidental, special or consequential loss arising out of, or in any way connected with the School or its provision of the courses.

Students are liable for any damage caused to the School's premises, property, instruments or any other items allowed to be used by the School at the School.

Termination

We may at any time at our sole discretion and without giving any reason or any prior notice terminate or temporarily suspend your access to the courses or our premises or any part thereof.
